Dear Friend of Children,

Thank you for your generosity and concern for the children in this home. You are an important part of changing their lives. I get to see the changes that are happening in their lives. Even though you may not get to see what I see, your support is helping make it happen.

Please let me share with you a project that I would deeply appreciate your help with this spring. The Dorm building is the oldest building on campus and has served thousands of children over the years. In 1989 the Board of Trustees began the Single Parent Alliance for Raising Kids (SPARK) ministry. As many of you already know, the building is block and brick construction and it is now more than 70 years old. This often causes remodeling to be expensive. Parts of the old Dorm building has been divided into apartments for single parent families.

There are many, many single parent families who need help. So, we need to *completely remodel* one area of the dorm where a make-shift apartment has been for years. Here are the needs:

- Complete demolition of the existing apartment.
- Fur out the walls so that insulation can be improved.
- Complete remodeling of the Kitchen-Plumbing, Electrical, Cabinets, Walls, Floor and Ceiling.
- New floors and drop the ceiling throughout the apartment
- Complete remodeling of the Bathroom-Plumbing, Electrical, Walls, Cabinets, Floor and Ceiling

The total estimated expense is \$30,500.00. The SPARK ministry is a growing ministry. There are calls every day of mothers desperately looking for help and hope. This apartment is not just a place where a family lives; it is where lives are changed forever. You are not just helping make a difference in the life of a child today, you are also making a difference in the lives of children of the next generation.

Will you give a gift of \$35, \$50, \$75, \$100, \$200, \$500, \$1,000, or any amount you care to give? Your gift will combine with other gifts to help accomplish remodeling of the apartment.
