Bible Drill Returns!

This month we started back meeting every Monday after school to have "Bible Drill". Paul Savage, once a resident here in the 1920's, brought the Bible Drill Program to Potter in the early 1990's. We have the same colorful chart still hanging that Paul made the children



all those years ago. The chart helps the children "drill" through the Bible. Verses that pertain to the plan of salvation, the chronology of the Bible, the books of the Bible and a variety of basic scriptures and much more. As we recite and work our way through the exercise, the children learn about the different people of the Bible, who they were and why they are important to us. The children take turns leading the different sections. It's a fun way to teach the children about God's word.


We have a brand new playground! This beautiful playground has been constructed behind the quadplex houses so that the children will have easy access to hours of fun under the sun. They can swing,

Wells Fargo, Gallup, Hezekiah, & Hank Williams WRITTEN BY DAVID DUNCAN

Wells Fargo knows money. Gallup knows research. In November of 2020, these two entities studied 1,709 Wells Fargo investors and



Only 4% of investors had complete estate plans.

Surprising? Perhaps -- especially if we consider the universal truth in Hebrews 9:27, "it is destined for people to die once" This 2020 research is just another study in a long line of studies that indicates many Americans do not have valid, up-to-date estate plans.

To be fair, most of us do not have the Hezekiah advantage either. Remember that good King of Judah? 2 Kings tell us that he did "what was right in the eyes of the Lord."

Hezekiah's advantage was that during a bad illness, God sent Isaiah the prophet with an unmistakable message, "Set your house in order, for you shall die, you shall not recover." (2 Kings 20:1 ESV) OK, at that point any of us would probably call for a lawyer and witnesses!

The research went on to show that higher income did not necessarily mean increased estate planning, but older age did. Only 30% of investors under age 50 had wills but for those over age 65, more than 4 of 5 had wills.

While not covered by the Gallup study, what would be interesting to know is how many Christian stewards have up-to-date plans. My sense is that if you live the faithful steward's life you may see an estate plan as your final act of stewardship and generosity.

One thing is for sure. As the late Hank Williams crooned in his popular song, "No matter how I struggle and strive, I'll never get out of this world alive."

There are many different programs in place for you to help the children and families served at Potter.

HONOR AND MEMORIAL GIFT You can help a child and, at the same time, comfort or surprise someone with a gift in their loved one's name. A Memorial Gift is a way to remember a loved one who has passed from this life. An Honor Gift is a way to remember a loved one's special occasion such as birthday, graduation, or an anniversary. After your gift is received, a letter will be sent to the person you wish to be acknowledged.

SPONSORSHIP There is no such thing as too many sponsors! The needs are never ending. There are individual sponsors that can help meet needs that might come up for individual children such as camp fees and athletic equipment. We also have activity sponsors, who are used to sponsor an outing for the residents or possibly even a campus event with other families.

APPEALS Each year five letters are mailed out to our donors. Each appeal has a project where your help is needed for it to be completed. Some are able to help with all the appeals, others choose the time of year when they are most able to help.

COMMODITIES Your congregation is asked to help with a cash gift for perishable items along with supplying items from a short grocery list of non perishables. A letter is sent in advance to let you know what is needed and when it will be picked up.

SILVER FOR CHILDREN During the first half of the year change cans are distributed to the congregations. The goal is to have the cans filled with silver coins and bills. We do, however, appreciate the pennies!!!! This is a great way for a family to participate together in helping to provide Christian environments for children, education costs, transportation costs, church activity costs and allowances for the children.

HANDS OF SERVICE This is our main donor program. Hands of Service offers you, our partner, an opportunity to assist the children on a regular basis. This could be monthly, bimonthly, quarterly, semi-annually or annually. Hands of Service is a commitment to the children. You are helping to fund their daily needs, just as you would your own.


